Fulfilling our mission by intentionally investing in student engagement:

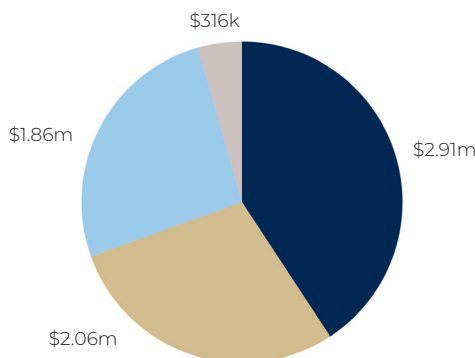
- Taste of Culture—many from the community participating (Photo, right)

Hundreds from the community and campus enjoyed unique good from dozens of cultures during Taste of Culture.

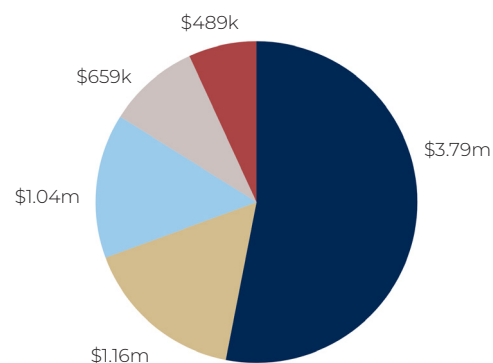
MINISTRY BREAKDOWN

May God continue to bless you as you continue to be an immense blessing to other students like me.

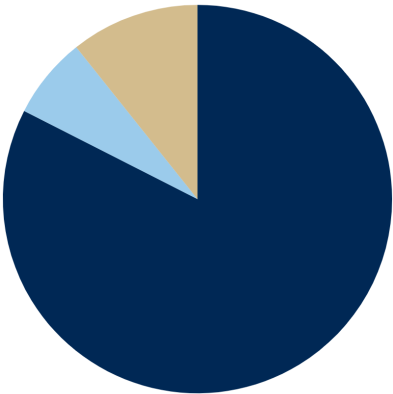
